At the May ACC meeting there were 3 requests that had been approved over email prior to the meeting: two for roofs and one to replace a concrete slab in front of the house. Two requests were approved at the meeting: one for solar panels and one to build/attach a new garage. Two information requests: approved fence colors and window replacements, will be answered by email.

The Committee discussed having First Service Residential send an addendum to homeowners who rent their property, on the rules and regulations of RHA such as: upkeep, trash, Townhome parking rules, etc.

The Committee meets once a month on the first Monday (June 5 this month). If you wish to submit an application for change, please do so two to three weeks prior to the meeting so that any questions can be answered before the meeting.

DID YOU KNOW... When submitting a change application, **ALL** details should be included in the application's description. Please do not submit an application stating that you want to install windows "like the ones in the brochure" and that's all you write. If you want to change your windows, in the description you should state the material, the style, the color, and whether there are mullions (grids). For example, in the application's description, it should state: "I want to install vinyl, double hung, white windows with mullions." That tells the ACC the material (vinyl), the style (double hung), the color (white), and whether there are mullions. If you also wish to include a brochure, you may do that **in addition** to the application.

DID YOU KNOW ... applications for change must be submitted by the homeowner, not a contractor, and must include the change application form at: https://rha-homes.org/acc-committee

DID YOU KNOW...Last year the Board approved a change to the guidelines. You are now able to plant vegetables and herbs in your front yard WITH THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS:

- -- Each vegetable or herb has a maximum height of 4 feet
- -- No part of any plant shall extend beyond the owner's yard
- -- After the growing season, plants must be removed.
- -- Failure to comply may result in an ACC violation/fine.

ed celebrating music day. Over 125 countries celebrated it in 2021.


